CONGRESS NEWS

The hotel is just minutes away from the World's largest Mall & Amusement Centre, West Edmonton Mall, and has great room rates starting at \$88 (\$98.62 with taxes) a night, single or double occupancy.

Doreen and I have been working on the content of the website and Doreen is responsible for all the formatting changes and keeping the website up-to-date. She has done a fabulous job!!! The following are some items Congress has been working on:

- **Westjet 10% discount.** Westjet has provided a booking account QC #4698 for the upcoming Canadian Shuffleboard Championships in Edmonton from September 30-October 07, 2007. This excludes web and promotional fares.

Westjet offers one complimentary ticket for every 50 seats booked. We were shy by 1-2 seats last year so maybe this year, we will break the 50+ mark. This complimentary ticket may be used for a draw or raffle item at the conference/convention only. So, please ensure Doreen is aware of your flight information if booking through Westjet.

- **CSC Logo.** As you can see from this Newsletter and the website, we are using our new Canadian Shuffleboard Congress logo! We have also designed new letterhead. We will have samples at the AGM.
- **3 way tie for 1st place.** Need to review possible rule change to the Playoff format. One suggestion came from Saskatchewan Shuffleboard Association from one of the players directly involved in the Men's Singles first place 3 way tie last year:

The tie breaker games to determine positioning should be best 2 out of 3 games and not a single game. In other words, a 2 out of 3 elimination match rather than single game elimination.

Please bring any other suggestions to the AGM.

- **National Sponsorship.** Nothing to report at this time. If any players have business contacts who may possibly be interested in being a national sponsor for CSC, please provide the contact information to one of the Congress Executive.
- **Rule Books.** The Rule Book has been added to the website. Some wording in the Rule Book needs to be reviewed and will be discussed at the AGM. An example would be:

5(a) Except in singles play, a player shall not walk past the FOUL LINE of the table or it constitutes a foul. PENALTY: Warning for the first offence and the loss of ONE (1) point for each succeeding offence in the same game or match.

Change to: ... Warning for first offence and award of one (1) point to the non-offending player(s) for each succeeding offence in the same game or match.

You can't take a point away so it has to be awarded to the other player(s).

Congratulations to all those players who qualified to represent their Charters at this year's Canadians – some to compete for another Canadian Championship, others competing for their first championship, and those attending the Canadians as first time competitors. We will all soon be meeting in Edmonton. Remember you can always check on the CSC website for more information i.e. hotel, Charter representatives, including information on the Canadian Open in Victoria, the Alberta Open on the May long weekend and the 2nd annual Saskatchewan Open on the July long weekend.

The Agenda for the 2007 AGM will soon be posted to the Congress website. Please advise me, or any member of the Congress Executive, of any items you wish added to the Annual General Meeting's Agenda.

Brian and I are looking forward to being a part of the Canadians in Edmonton and seeing everyone soon.

HALL OF FAME

The Hall of Fame (HOF) Committee would like to propose the following changes to the nomination process:

- The HOF Committee has the ability to nominate and induct, at any time, a player or builder who meets the qualifications.
- The HOF Committee will review, nominate and induct up to 5 players and 2 Promoters from the players of the Hosting Charter of that year's Canadian Championships. For example, this year would be Shuffleboard Association of Alberta and next year would be Saskatchewan Shuffleboard Association.
- Players and Promoters can continue to be nominated by players and/or Charters as long as those individuals meet the HOF requirements.
- If a Player or Promoter is nominated by the HOF Committee, then the Player's/Promoter's Charter will be responsible for supplying a history or a biography of the individual who is being inducted.
- The Canadian Shuffleboard Congress will be responsible for the banquet tickets for those being inducted and who will attend the Awards banquet.
- Any individual who is being inducted that cannot attend, or is deceased, will be inducted in a ceremony at the Hospitality Night (Monday), as well as being mentioned at the Awards banquet.

I am pleased to advise that the following six Players and/or Promoters will be inducted into the Canadian Shuffleboard Congress Hall of Fame at this year's Canadians:

Sandy Sandquist as a Promoter. Sandy was a pioneer/founder of shuffleboard in Canada.

Dave Neufeld as a Promoter. Dave was the first President of the Canadian Shuffleboard Congress.

Art Evans, Saskatchewan Shuffleboard Association, as a Player and Promoter. I am certain there is not one shuffleboarder from across Canada who has not met or knows Art Evans.

Sharon Juhlke, Vancouver Island Shuffleboard Association, as a Player – 13 Canadian Championships.

Jim Nicoll, Shuffleboard Association of Alberta, as a Player – 12 Canadian Championships.

Kelly Restau, Shuffleboard Association of Alberta, as a Player – 7 Canadian Championships.
